# KITCHEN WASTE

- Fruits, vegetables and skins
- · Bread, cereal, pasta, cakes
- Meat and dairy products
- · Coffee filters and tea bags
- Leftovers and moldy food (WITHOUT PACKAGING)

### PAPER AND CARDBOARD SOILED WITH FOOD

- Paper towels, paper hand towels, napkins, Kleenex
- Paper placemats and tablecloths
- Pizza boxes, paper baking cups
- · Paper plates and cups

#### **GARDEN WASTE**

- · Grass cuttings, leaves and pine needles
- · All garden waste
- Small branches [max. of 2 cm (3/4 in.) in diameter and 60 cm (2 ft.) in length]
- Sawdust, bark, wood chips (NOT treated or painted)

#### **OTHER**

- · Shredded paper
- COLD or wet ashes
- · Pet litter

## MATERIALS REFUSED IN THE BROWN BIN

- · Dead animals
- · Diapers, tampons, sanitary napkins
- Cotton swabs, cotton balls, make-up remover pads and baby wipes

- Cigarette butts
- · Paper and cardboard soaked with toxic products
- All plastic bags and plastic items

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Place newspaper or cardboard at the bottom of the roll-out bin to facilitate emptying and absorb extra liquid.
- Place materials loosely in bin PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
- In the fall, place your extra leaves in PAPER bags next to the bin.
